That sound, so familiar to anyone who travelled in the slam door EMUs on the Southern Region, can be heard this year at Warcop.

On the third Sunday of each month (16<sup>th</sup> June, 21<sup>st</sup> July, 18<sup>th</sup> August, 15<sup>th</sup> September & 20<sup>th</sup> October) the Eden Valley Railway's passenger service will be operated by a pair of Motor Luggage Vans working on battery power with a 4-CEP in use for passengers.

Trains will depart Warcop Station at 1100 and hourly until 1600 and will cover the whole of our current operational line on each journey (2 miles 19 chains each way).

Normal fares apply, and driver for a fiver using an 0-4-0 diesel hydraulic locomotive will also be available on the day.
